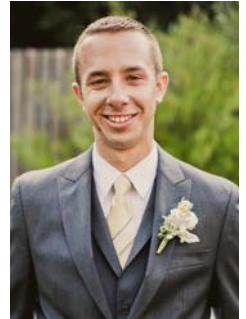

Anaheim 207 Living Past Masters

Brethren,

We have lost two Brothers who demitted to the Celestial Lodge above where the Great Architect of the Universe Forever Presides.

Br. David Emory Nelson died August 11 2015 at the age of 94 in Los Angeles. David was born February 25, 1921, a twin, in Alamosa, Colo. Br. David served in the Army Air Corps as a tail gunner and flew 65 missions in the B-26 Marauder. Br. Nelson was Initiated on April 9, 1963, Passed Oct. 29, 1963 and Raised on Feb. 25, 1964, his 43rd birthday, in Angeles-Mesa Lodge #625, now Anaheim #207. Br. Nelson was honored with the Golden Veteran Award in February of this year by Anaheim Lodge.

Br. Richard Morris Gates died August 21, 2015 at the age of 77 in Villa Park. Richard was born June 30, 1938 in Orange, Calif. Br. Gates was Initiated on Oct. 28, 1966, Passed Mar. 23, 1967 and Raised to the Sublime Degree Jan. 26, 1968 in Anaheim Lodge #207. A Masonic Memorial Service was held on Sept. 26 at Canyon Hills Presbyterian, Anaheim Hills.
