Happy New Year Brethren from the East,

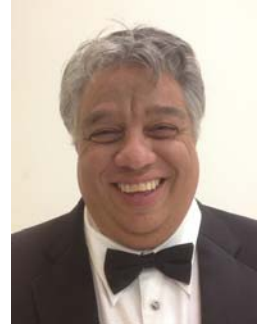
I am very pleased and excited to start fresh this new year, and the new adventure we're about to begin.
