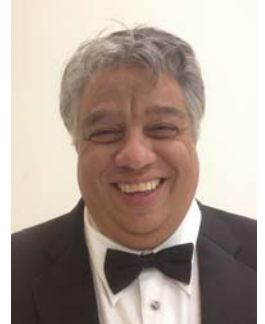
Master's Message
