My Brethren,

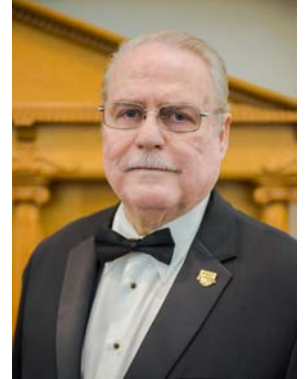
