On July 19th we conferred the Third Degree on Brother Johnnie Nix, he has worked hard and strong to attain his status as Master Mason.

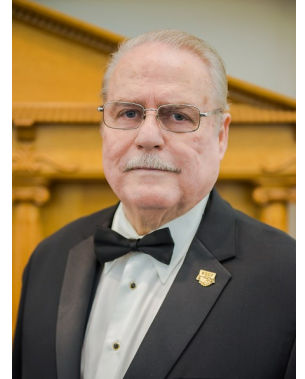
